Data Enhancement for Tracking Graduates in Italy

ERASMUS-EDU-2024-GRADU-TRACKING-IBA

AlmaLaurea Interuniversity Consortium, as the designated body responsible for implementing the Eurograduate 2026 Survey in Italy, pledges to continue the regular data collection activities established during the previous Eurograduate 2022 pilot survey, aiming at producing comparable and longitudinal data at EU level by tracking graduates from the learning outcomes of higher education to the characteristics of their employment paths.

A National Research Team in charge of the preparation, implementation and dissemination of the survey will be appointed at the scope.

A specific Eurograduate data collection will be launched in autumn 2026 with the following envisaged characteristics: representative sample of 2024/2025 (T+1) and 2020/2021 (T+5) graduates population in Italy for EQF levels 6 and 7; representativeness of the sample across gender, fields of study, types of higher education institution and geographical area of the university; provision of unit-level micro data on essential information ensuring the comparability across EU countries.

- To disseminate the survey results to potential stakeholders
