It is a structural project designed to **enhance the vocation of universities to interact with labour markets and society**, encouraging regional integration and cooperation among higher education institutions in Lebanon, Morocco and Tunisia. The sharing of good practices, their adaptation to different national contexts, trainings and pilot projects implemented at partner universities level allowed to **strengthen a permanent dialogue on graduates employability and entrepreneurial spirit**.



Specific objectives

- To improve the quality of higher education and its efficacy with respect to labour markets
- To promote regional integration and cooperation through the sharing of good practices
- To strengthen the interaction among universities, firms and local, national and regional authorities
- To identify and implement the best practices for the promotion of entrepreneurial spirit, the strengthening of graduates employability in Lebanon, Morocco and Tunisia



Key results

- 7 national conferences for the presentation of 308 good practices on graduates employability
- 16 good practices on graduates employability applied to local Lebanon, Moroccan and Tunisian contexts
- Delivery of a training course on entrepreneurial behavior addressed to 146 master students
- Signature of 85 internship conventions with firms and 143 internships carried out by selected students
- Organization of 6 national competitions to identify the most innovative projects by young graduates entrepreneurs and of 1 international Start Cup Competition
- Creation of a Sub-Network on graduates employability
