"TUnisian Network for Employability and Development of graduates' skills" 573778-EPP-1-2016-IT-EPPKA2-CBHE-SP

It is a structural project designed to support the reform of the higher education system in Tunisia, in order to foster the matching between academic supply and labour market needs, improving the efficacy of the system through a certified model of quality assurance, the monitoring of academic courses and their efficacy. The model is based on 4 pillars: a web platform matching supply of and demand for qualified labour; surveys on the graduates' profile and employment status; transversal promotional activities addressed to students, graduates, firms, policy makers.

Specific objectives

- To strengthen Tunisian capacities by transferring European good practices on graduates employability and monitoring of universities performances
- To increase the empowering of Tunisian universities
- To reinforce the links between academia and labour markets
- To foster the collaboration among universities at national level
- To improve the quality of the Tunisian higher education system in accordance with international standards

Key results

- 26.876 students and 118 firms registered on the web platform
- 3 survey reports on the 2017, 2018, 2019 graduates' profile produced
- 1 survey report on 2016 graduates' employment status at 3 years from graduation produced
- 38 statisticians, IT and administrative staff trained
- 1 training manual addressed to placement officers from partner universities
- 55 project promotional local seminars addressed to students and firms held
- 5 national dissemination conferences organized
- 1 methodological guidelines for the future development of graduates surveys elaborated
- 1 project sustainability plan drafted
