





TRACED Project "Towards Regular Availability of Comparative European Data on graduates"

ERASMUS-EDU-2021-GRADUATE TRACKING-IBA

The AlmaLaurea Interuniversity Consortium coordinates the TRACED project in the framework of the second phase of the Eurograduate 2022 pilot survey promoted by the European Commission in 17 countries. The initiative aims at making more available the comparative analysis on the graduates' employment condition, in order to allow European universities to adapt their academic supply and to support policy makers in the improvement of graduates' employability tackling the gap between demand for competences required by the labour markets and the supply of competences acquired by the graduates, in order to fostering better social inclusion, accessibility and mobility. The TRACED project foresees the set-up of a national research team comprising representatives from the Italian Ministry of Higher Education and Research (MUR), National Institute of Statistics (ISTAT) and experts from AlmaLaurea, to implement the Eurograduate 2022 initiative in Italy.

Specific objectives



- To adapt the national survey questionnaire to the Eurograduate requirements
- To develop the national survey on 2016-2017 graduates at 5 years from graduation and on 2020-2021 graduates at 1 year from graduation, guaranteeing the comparability of data
- To systematize the survey results in a technical report
- To conduct two feasibility studies on the integration of national data from administrative sources

- Condution of interviews to graduates
- Cleaning and analysis of data
- Draft of the survey report
- Preparation of infographics, promotional brochures and video
- Organization of 3 dissemination events
