







ERASMUS-EDU-2021-GRADUATE TRACKING-IBA Duration: 24 months (February 2022 – January 2024)

- To develop the European survey on the employment condition of graduates in Italy by participating in the second phase of the European initiative EUROGRADUATE, aiming at creating an integrated European information system on graduates by 2030.
- To cooperate with the European stakeholders for increasing the availability of comparable data and research on the employment condition of graduates in the 17 countries involved.

To run the EUROGRADUATE 2022 survey on graduates in Italy based on the AlmaLaurea experience.



To create the **National Research Team** consisting of members appointed by AlmaLaurea, MUR and ISTAT ensuring a smooth implementation of project activities and the medium-long perspective of the project scope.



To release a report on the employment condition of graduates in Italy comparable at European level.



To conduct two feasibility studies on the integration of AlmaLaurea, MUR and ISTAT databases on graduates.



To disseminate the project activities and the survey results to potential stakeholders.

## METHODOLOGICAL APPROACH

### **CENSUS SURVEY**

Web and telephone interviews (CAWI+CATI)

- ~300,000 graduates of the 2020/2021 academic year contacted at 1 year from graduation.
- ~270,000 graduates of the 2017 solar year contacted at 5 years from graduation.

## **SAMPLE SURVEY**

Telephone interviews (CATI)

~2,500 graduates of the 2020/2021 academic year interviewed at 1 year from graduation for an update on their employment condition in November 2022.

**Stratification variables**: field of study, type of degree, geographical area of the university.
