

MOTIVE Project

"Monitoring Trends In Vietnamese Graduates Employment"

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The MOTIVE project, **coordinated by AlmaLaurea** and supported by the Ministry of Education of the Republic of Vietnam, responds to the challenge of reforming the country policy for the monitoring of the transition of graduates to the labor markets and their employment status. The **first National Center for Graduates Tracking in Vietnam** will be realized at the scope. Through the Center, the first graduate tracking survey will be conducted thanks to a capacity transfer to the partner universities, supported by the feedback provided by a network of stakeholders during the life cycle of the project. Training courses and workshops aimed at Vietnamese university staff, on the management and use of survey data and on European standards and good practices, constitute a pillar of the initiative.



Specific objectives

- To provide the tools for the conduction of graduate surveys
- To improve the ability to use graduates data for the adoption of quality assurance measures
- To strengthen the connection between universities and society for monitoring the higher education system's and graduates' performances

Expected results

- Creation of the National Center for Graduates Tracking in Vietnam
- Development of a methodology and a unique questionnaire for graduates tracking surveys
- Set-up of an international network of stakeholders
- Organization of workshops and training activities for university staff
